Summer Programs Fair and Math and Science Night

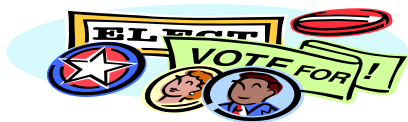
Friday April 25th 5pm-6:30pm. Drop the kids off in the gym for some fun, while you check out all the summer activities that are being offered this summer.
